

Brief Bio: H. Clifford Lane, a native of Detroit, Michigan, received his M.D. degree from the University of Michigan in 1976. He then completed an internship and residency at the University of Michigan Hospital, Ann Arbor, Michigan. In 1979, Dr. Lane came to the National Institutes of Health (NIH) as a clinical associate in the Laboratory of Immunoregulation (LIR) at the National Institute of Allergy & Infectious Diseases (NIAID). In 1985, he was appointed Deputy Clinical Director, NIAID and in 1989, he became the Chief of the Clinical and Molecular Retrovirology Section (CMRS) of the LIR, a position he still holds. In 1991, Dr. Lane became Clinical Director of NIAID and in 2006, Director of the Division of Clinical Research and NIAID Deputy Director for Clinical Research and Special Projects.

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
